LENNOX CHASE FAST FACTS 2003-2008

- 87 tenants have resided at Lennox chase since 11/17/03.
- 26 or 30% of the 87 tenants were female.
- 61 or 70% of the 87 tenants were male.
- The youngest tenant was a male 21 years old.
- The oldest tenant was a male 70 years old.
- 4 or 5% of the 87 tenants were between 20 and 29 years old.
- 16 or 18% of the 87 tenants were between 30 and 39 years old.
- 31 or 36% of the 87 tenants were between 40 and 49 years old.
- 29 or 33% of the 87 tenants were between 50 and 59 years old.
- 6 or 7% of the 87 tenants were between 60 and 69 years old.
- 1 or 1% of the tenants was between 70 and 79 years old.
- 17 or 20% of the 87 tenants were over 55 years old.
- 57 or 66% of the 87 tenants were African American.
- 29 or 33% of the 87 tenants were Caucasian.
- 1 or 1% of the 87 tenants were Native American.
- 78 or 90% of the 87 tenants had a reported history of substance abuse or mental illness.
- 72 or 83% of the 87 tenants had a reported history of substance abuse.
- 38 or 44% of the 87 tenants had a reported history of mental illness.
- 32 or 37% of the 87 tenants were dully diagnosed.
- 9 or 10% of the 87 tenants had no reported history of substance abuse or mental illness.
- 58 or 67% of the 87 tenants were employed full time.
- \$7.92 was the average estimated hourly rate of pay.
- \$16,663.72 was the average estimated annual rate of pay.
- 2 or 2% received SSI.
- 26 or 30% received SSDI
- 2 or 2% received VA benefits.
- 5 or 6% worked part time to supplement their income.
- 45 or 52% of the 87 tenants had some form of medical benefits.
- Two years is the average length of stay at Lennox chase.
- 7 or 19% of the original 36 tenants still reside at Lennox Chase.
- 56 tenants have moved from Lennox Chase.
- 27 or 48% of those 56 tenants moved in to other permanent housing.
- 20 or 36% of those 56 tenants have maintained other permanent housing.
- 25 or 45% of the those 56 tenants left Lennox Chase due to substance abuse related issues.
- 4 or 7% of the 56 tenants passed away.
- 15 or 27% of the 56 tenants had an eviction filed against them. 14 of those tenants had substance abuse related issues that contributed to their eviction.
